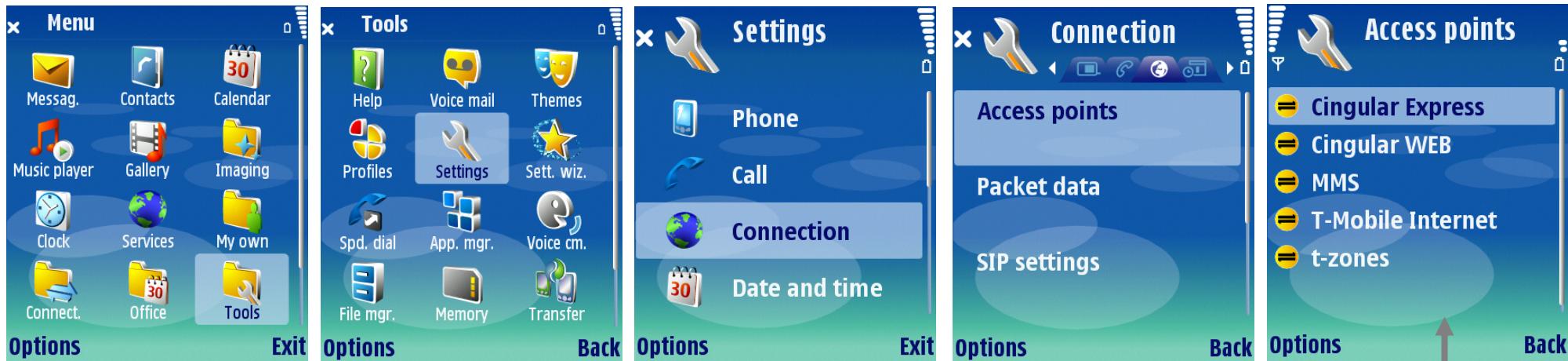


Configuring GPRS

Menu | Tools | Settings | Connection | Access points



How to determine if you have GPRS settings?

1. Navigate to “**Tools**” using the Menu button and select
2. Select the menu option “**Settings**”
3. Select the menu option “**Connection**”
4. Select the menu option “**Access Points**”

Depending on your Service Provider name you should have access points listed.

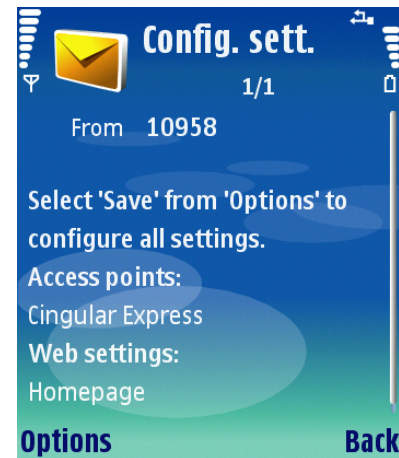

1. Select what type of configuration settings* and follow onscreen instructions.

2. Once the settings are received on the device you can save them by selection Options | Save **
